The school operates a breakfast club between 07:30 and the start of the school day and an after school club from the end of the school day until 18:00, 17.30 on Fridays.

The club operates on the school site with staff employed by us.

The cost is £3.00 per hour, charged in blocks of 30 minutes so that parents only pay for the time they use the club. Breakfast costs £1.00 and tea costs £1.00.
