Headline - Anti-Bullying Week

This week has been National Anti-Bullying Week.

This year the national theme launched by the Anti-Bullying Alliance was 'Choose Respect.'

Anti-Bullying Week shines a spotlight on bullying and encourages all children, teachers and parents to take action against bullying throughout the year.

Aims:

This Anti-Bullying Week focused on:

- empowering children and young people to celebrate what makes them, and others, unique
- helping children and young people understand how important it is that every child feels valued and included in school, able to be themselves, without fear of bullying
- encouraging parents and carers to work with their school and talk to their children about bullying, difference and equality
- enabling teachers and other children's workforce professionals to celebrate what makes us 'all different, all equal' and celebrate difference and equality. Encouraging them to take individual and collective action to prevent bullying, creating safe environments where children can be themselves.
