#### **Sex and Relationship Education**

As you know and we have mentioned in previous newsletters. Sex and Relationship Education (SRE) becoming statutory next year. Mrs Marie (in her role as Specialist Leader of Education and Chartered Teacher for PSHE) has been working with the Medway Public Health team to design and plan curriculum resources.
