Welcome to term 5!

This is always a busy term with lots going on. Here's a quick overview of events and planned learning for the term.

FS1

Lots of new and interesting resources have been added to the Nursery to stimulate children's curiosity, imagination and development. There will be a singing event to learn the songs we are learning. It will be on Friday 10th May at 11.10am for morning pupils and 3.00pm for afternoon pupils.

FS2

Learning about minibeasts and Spring time. They will be investigating spiders, ladybirds and other insects by going on bug hunts, researching and recording their learning in fact sheets. There will be Family Friday on 17th May - watch out for more details!

Learning about sea adventures and explorers. They will be researching the life of Christopher Columbus and learning about oceans and continents. There will be a phonics event on 2nd May at 2:45pm - hope to see you there!

Year 2

Year 2 will be learning about Victorians and focusing on the life of a Victorian child including school and work. There will be a parent reading event on 9th May at 3pm and a family sewing circle on 15th May @ 2:30pm

LKS2

Their topic is the Tudors, which will also form the basis of their RWI work this term too. They will be focusing on life in the time of Henry VIII and learning about his wives, Tudor schools, children and religion. There will be a family art event on Wednesday 22nd May @ 2:45pm, where you will get the chance to do some

drawing with your children and learn more about the excellent peer critique strategies they have been learning.

UKS2

UKS2 will be continuing with learning around the USA and this term focusing on 20th Century America. There will be a showcase event on Wednesday 22nd May – watch this space for more details.

In addition to the above events we are also delighted to offer parents / carers the chance to attend a couple of other open sessions.
